Nitobe Inazō (新渡戸 稲造) was the author of “Bushido: The Soul of Japan” (1900). He was the Deputy-Secretary-General of the League of Nations. He became the director of the International Bureau Section, in charge of the International Committee on Intellectual Cooperation (predecessor of UNESCO). He was also an educator, an agricultural economist, and a government official. The author of the book, Prof. Kusahara will talk about the life of Nitobe Inazo, and we will discuss future of international cooperation and Japan.
